SHOW TIMES: Please check the website www.mmdco.org under 'Login' then 'newsletter' for the list of what classes will be participating in which show. Some classes may be in both shows. **DATES:** The date of the recital is **Saturday June 8th**, **2013 at Milford High.** There is a mandatory rehearsal June 6th or 7th. We will be having two shows, a morning and evening show. I have a list of which classes will be in which shows. Tickets will be going on sale May 13th at the studio at 1pm and all seats will be assigned. In order to purchase your tickets you must pay May as well as any other remaining balances. Each family will be allowed to get 8 tickets to start for each show, and later as families don't get their allotted 8, those seats become available for purchase. In years past everyone that has wanted extra seats has gotten them. **PRACTICE!** Please review dances at home

and feel free to ask the teachers about videoing the

Pictures will be taken during your regular class times. The dates are **Monday May 20 – Thursday May 23**. Saturday classes will need to contact the front desk for exact times, as all Saturday classes will come on **Wednesday** to have their pictures taken. Students should be dressed in their costumes with their hair done and ready to go by their regular class time. After pictures they will be rehearsing in their costumes for the remainder of their class time. **Please make sure all nail polish and jewelry are removed for both pictures and recital!

Recital Hair & Make-up list

Hair -Classical Bun: tight and slicked back

Eyes - Brown and pink eye shadow

- Black Mascara

- Black Eye liner optional

Cheeks - Rose colored Lips - Medium dark pink

The make-up helps the dancers faces to not get washed out by the lights. Ages 7 and up should wear a little more then day to day make-up, 3-6 year olds could wear a little less.

Make Sure to remove all jewelry and nail polish for rehearsal and recital

Recital Tips

- Arrive at the school 1 hour before the show, dressed and ready to go for the 1st dance.
- Dancers should wear their nude leotard closest to their body. Tights go over the nude leotard.
- No underwear under tights
- Be sure ALL jewelry and nailpolish has been removed
- Label any additional costumes and accessories with the student name, class time and teacher's name. Many parents use a clear garment bag, labeled, with a smaller labeled plastic bag for accessories. (You still should label the actual items, even if they are in a bag)
- Label all tights, shoes, leotards. We have 400 children, so it's important that dancers keep their area tidy, in a bag or bin, and labeled. Many parents use a plastic tub to keep students items organized.
- Pack a small bag with extra safety pins, hair ties, bobby pins, a hairbrush, hairspray, tissue, and makeup- all labeled (please see make-up colors for details)
- Students will be there for 3 ½ hours from the time they arrive to the time they leave. Please prepare your child with what to expect so they find the experience an enjoyable one! We have many loving parents backstage that will help, and treat your child like their own. (please don't forget to sign up to help!)
- Please feel free to pack your child legos, crayons (no markers!), games, activity books, books, a blanket to sit on, etc. Quiet, appropriate movies or hand-held games are acceptable, however keep in mind MMDCo and volunteer parents are not responsible for lost or damaged items, so please consider this when packing personal items.
- <u>Food:</u> Dancers should eat a good meal before coming to the show. Please pack your student a small snack for back stage—ONLY things that **will not** stain the costumes.
- <u>Food Recommendations to pack:</u> green grapes, carrot/celery sticks, pretzels, animal crackers, fruit snacks, cheese sticks, crackers & cheese. **Water is the only acceptable drink to pack.**
- Please absolutely NO peanut products!

*Parents and Caregivers:

<u>Please read this important Note</u> For the safety of the dancers, during the show no parents/guests are allowed backstage until the end of the show unless they have prior approval. Please tell any of your guests this information. This is for the safety of all the dancers. There are absolutely no exceptions.
